Ensure the essay is in PDF format and adheres to the specified guidelines.

Word Limit and Format:

Essays should be between 800 to 1000 words.

Font: Times New Roman, Font Size: 12, Double-spaced.

Evaluation Criteria:

- Relevance to the topic.
- Originality and creativity of ideas.
- Clarity of expression and coherence of the essay.
- Adherence to grammatical rules and language proficiency.

Deadline:

Submission deadline will be clearly mentioned on the competition page of the website.

Prizes:

Details about prizes and awards will be announced on the competition page.

Debate Competition:

Each participant can participate in the debate competition.

Topic:

The topic for the debate competition is "Audiologist and Audiological Practice".

Participants opting for online mode must upload their debate video on the official IHS website (ihs.ac.in) under the designated section.

Offline Participation:

Participants opting for offline mode must visit the IHS campus and follow the on-site registration process.
